Indoor Events Checklist

PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

- Who needs a license?
 - o Facilities that host 50 or more patrons at a time.
 - o Entertainment Venues: Concerts, plays, films & videos, dances, games
 - o Sports Venues: Fitness facilities, indoor sporting facilities
 - o Gathering Venues: For gathering large public or private groups indoors
- Before beginning operations, check with the Planning department to ensure that the property is properly zoned by calling 616-456-4100.
- Facilities adhere to times of operation stated in the ordinance:
 - o In or within 200 feet of a residential district 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.
 - o More than 200 feet from a residential district − 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.
- Exceptions:
 - o Any Indoor events operated by a governmental entity.
 - o Any Indoor events within an educational institution.

	Non-refundable application fee.
	Applicants will be contacted by the Fire Department to schedule a fire inspection.
	License must be displayed openly on the property where all customers can see.
