## Mobile Vending Cart Checklist

### PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

- Carts may only be operated outside of the Downtown area and carts must remain in motion when not actively making a sale.
- The license is issued to the Owner of the business, additional employees are covered under the owner's license.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Completed Mobile Vending Cart Application (part I and II).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Completed Affidavit and Indemnity Agreement.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Non-refundable application fee
<input type="checkbox"/>	License must be kept with cart and produced upon request.
