	<b>Reduce the amount of total suspended solids in the GVRBA recycle stream by 10% in 2014 versus 2013.</b>
	<b>To procure and hire (6) each Operator / Maintainer positions by end of calendar year 2014.</b>
	<b>To clean all sanitary sewers 24" in diameter and smaller once every five years.</b>
	<b>Determine construction material of 50% of the sanitary sewer pipelines with unknown composition, in order to better maintain the sanitary sewer system.</b>
	<b>Monitor the GVRBA Biosolids cake per 503 regulations for the regulated metals, ensuring the Biosolids meet the exemplary quality (EQ) limits for potential land application.</b>
	<b>IPP (Industrial Pretreatment) shall send permit renewal letters to significant industrial users ninety (90) days prior to permit expiration.</b>
	<b>IPP (Industrial Pretreatment) shall complete permit renewals to significant industrial users thirty (30) days prior to permit expiration when permit application is received on time.</b>
