**SUBJECT:**    **REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF BORDERLINE STREETS**

**PURPOSE:**    To define the basis upon which the City of Grand Rapids shall enter into agreements with other municipalities for the repair and maintenance of borderline streets.

**POLICY:**

Background

It is to the mutual benefit of the City of Grand Rapids and other municipalities to cooperate in the repair and maintenance, including snow removal, ice control, sweeping and flushing of the vehicular roadway surfaces, pavements and supporting structures in an economical and efficient manner on certain streets which lie on their mutual boundaries.

Policy

1. The portion of streets and roadways to be repaired by the respective municipalities shall be explicitly defined.
2. Each municipality shall keep an accurate record of costs and expenses including a pro rata share of overhead expense and render an accounting to the other party for the work done at agreed upon intervals.
3. Each of the parties shall then pay to the other party its proportional share of the expense so indicated during the next ensuing month following said accounting.
4. Any major construction, reconstruction or grade crossing work to be done as determined by either municipality, shall be completed on such basis as the parties may agree upon at that time.
5. Agreements shall continue in force until revoked by either party by giving three months written notice of revocation to the other party.
