

SUBJECT: **DETERMINATION OF LOW INCOME HOUSING NEEDS**

PURPOSE: To determine alternatives for providing adequate housing for the lower income families, handicapped, disabled, senior citizens and the homeless.

POLICY:

1. The Housing Assistance Plan and the comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan as prepared by the Planning and Development Service Group will serve as the basis of detailed surveys of housing conditions, family composition, family income and related matters to be completed within approximately three year period after federal approval of such plan.
2. Federal and State legislation which will upgrade the condition of the existing housing stock will provide additional standard housing for low income families, elderly, disabled, handicapped and the homeless will be evaluated and considered.
3. The City Commission will evaluate the facts in the contemplated studies and formulate a program around the several possible alternatives of new public and private housing for low income families and rehabilitation of substandard housing.
