## User Guide: NMF Idea Submission

This guide will take you step-by-step through the Neighborhood Match Fund (NMF) Idea Submission form. We will show you what to expect when submitting your NMF idea, and further explain what we are asking from you each step of the way.

Actual submissions must be done online at <a href="https://www.grandrapidsmi.gov/nmf">www.grandrapidsmi.gov/nmf</a> by the due date.

You will be asked:

1.	Are you a resident of Grand Rapids?  Yes  No - If "No" is selected, please STOP. You are not eligible to submit a project idea. Only GR residents are eligible. Perhaps you can co-lead with a GR resident on this project. Have the GR resident fill out this form.
