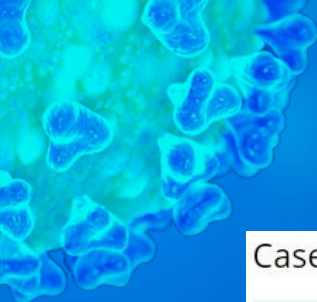

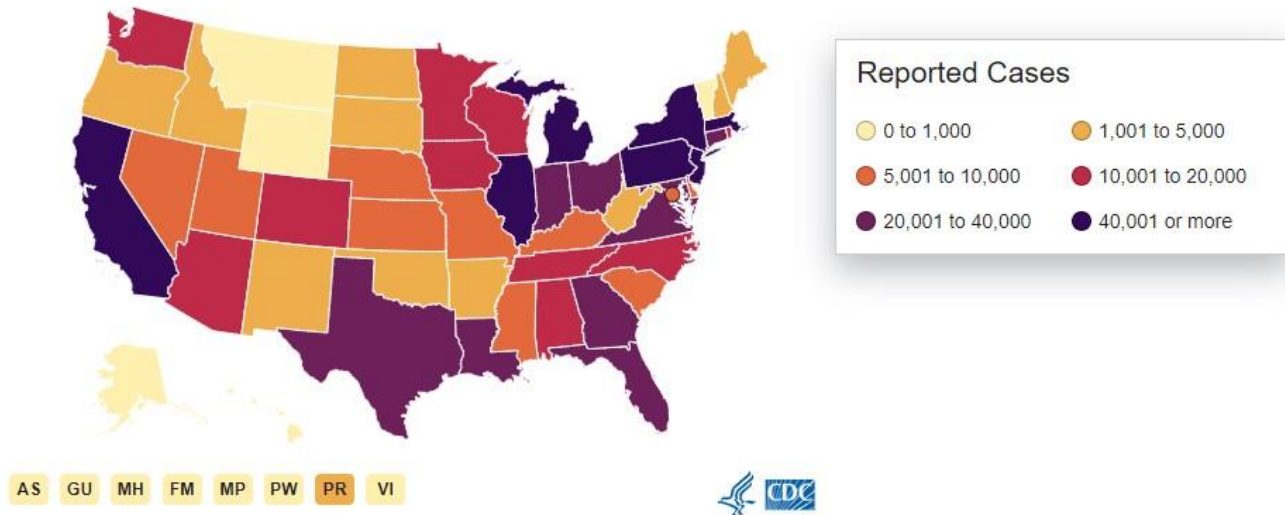

City of Grand Rapids Update

- COVID-19 testing was offered to public safety and essential employees.
- Building inspection services resumed.
- Carts can now be used at golf course.
- Fulton Care Center is operational.
- Submitted CARES Act needs to the County.

City of Grand Rapids Recovery Update

Outdoor Space Activation Working Group

- Goal: Support hospitality (food/beverage) businesses and help reactivate business districts by dramatically increasing available outdoor space.
- Initial focus is on maximizing use of existing authorities: Special Events policies, right-of-way utilization policies, SDM/catering licenses, etc.
- City and DGRI staff, consulting with Health Department and other partners as needed.
- Currently mapping areas of opportunity, drafting proposed seating layouts, analyzing policies.
- Additional info, with possibility of policy proposal, on May 19.



City of Grand Rapids Reopening Strategy

Reopening Objectives

- Ensure the safety and welfare of employees and community members visiting City facilities.
- Maintain timely, consistent, and accurate public messaging about the physical changes at City facilities.
- Conduction ongoing operational risk assessments of each City facility and ensure controls are in place to isolate and contain the spread of disease from infectious individuals.
- Continue to review service levels and prepare plans to meet service goals.
