Period of Performance: October 17, 2016 – October 16, 2019



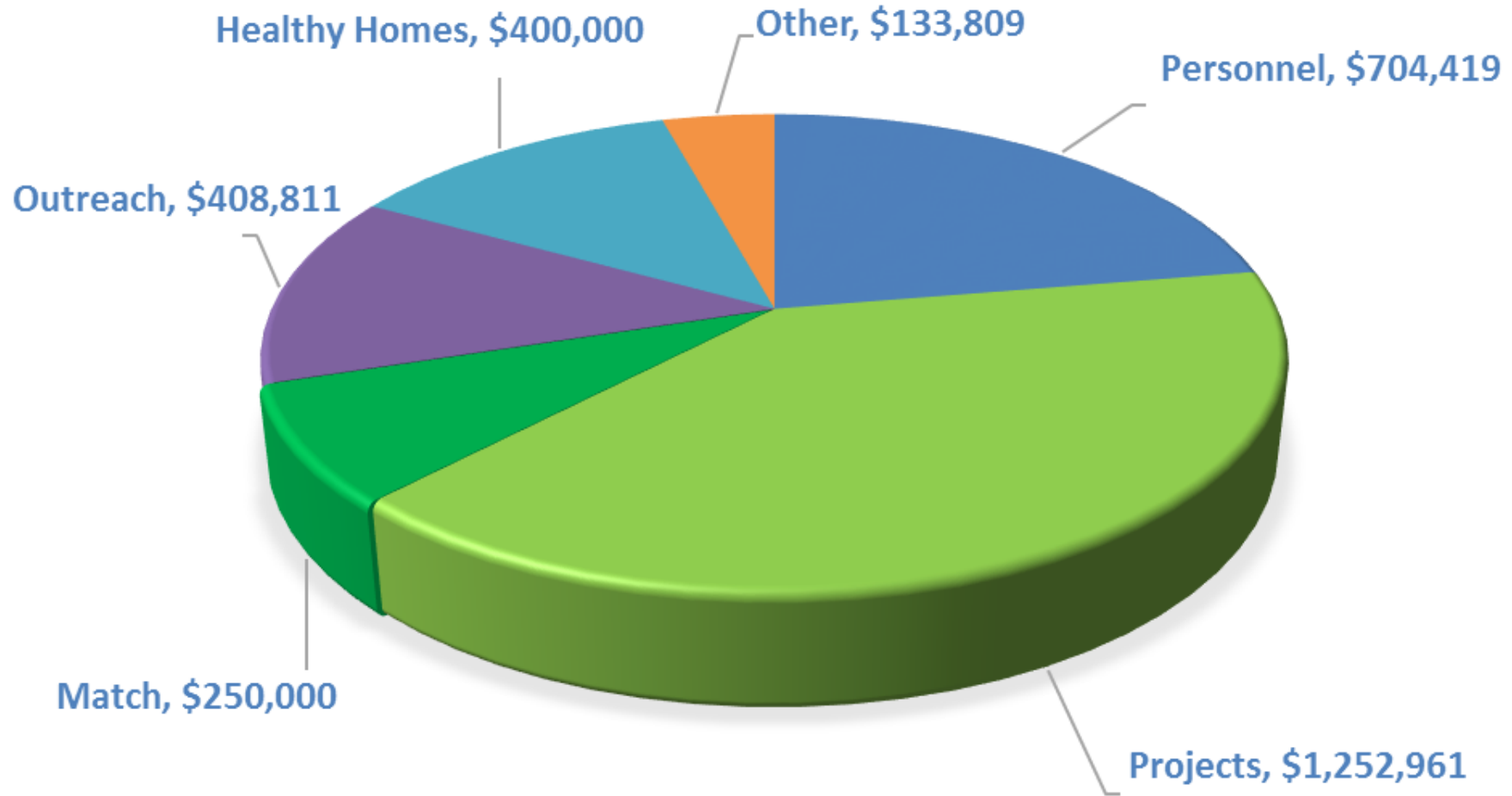
LEAD BASED PAINT HAZARD CONTROL PROGRAM (continued)

Planned Program Goals:

- Assess 160 homes for lead paint hazards
- Eliminate lead paint hazards in 150 homes
- Train 750 individuals in lead safe practices

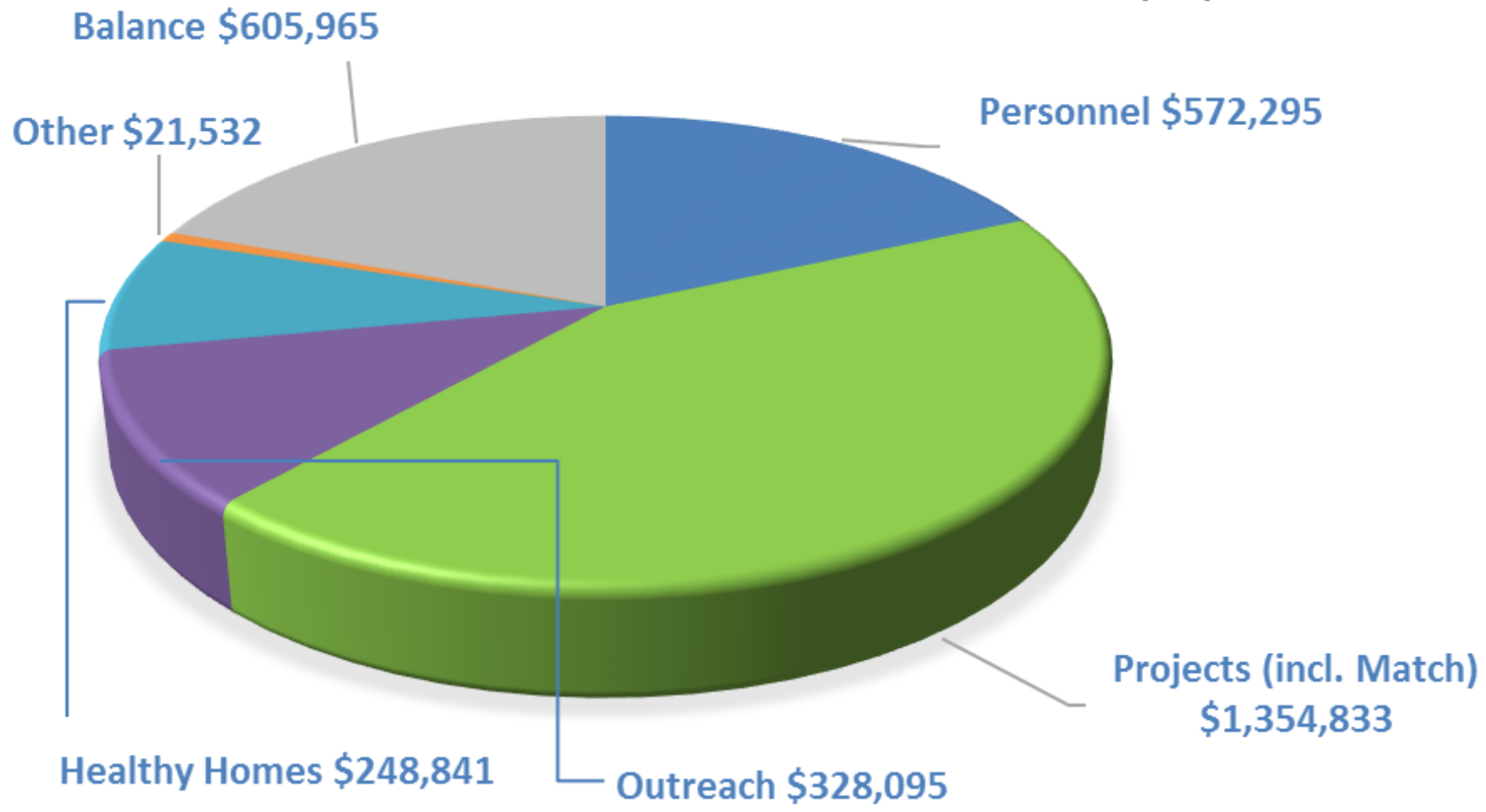

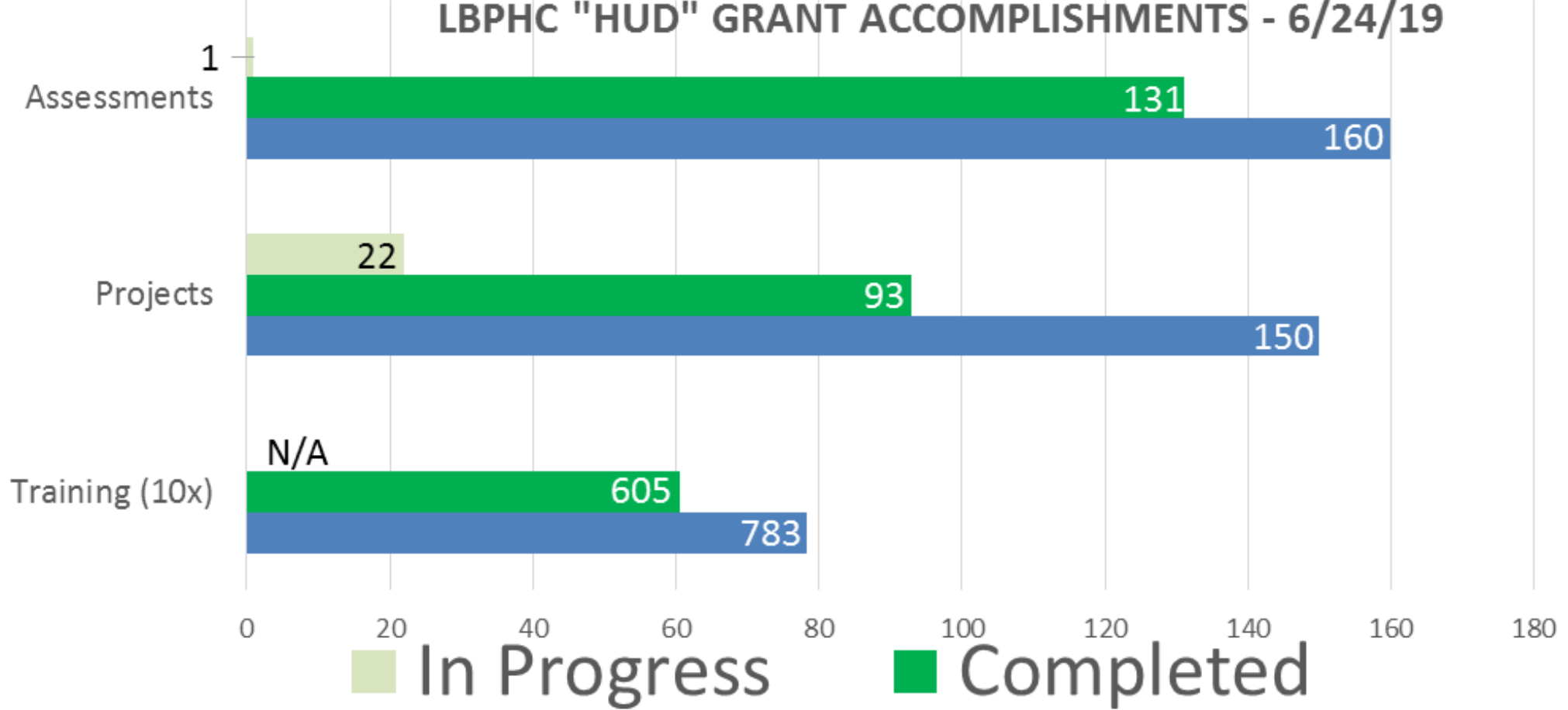

Period of Performance: October 1, 2018 – September 30, 2019



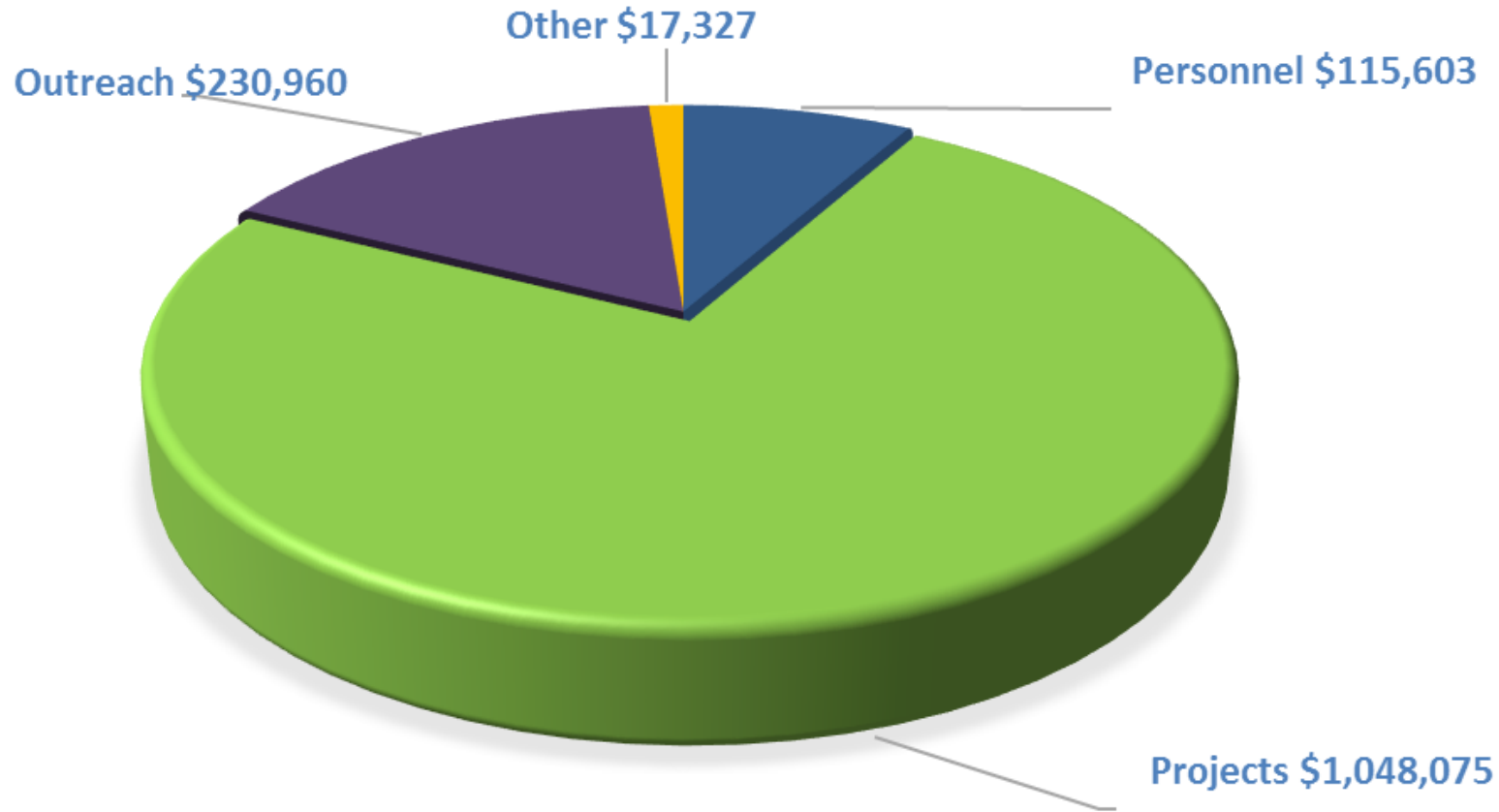
LEAD HAZARD CONTROL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (continued)

- Enhance community capacity to address lead hazards

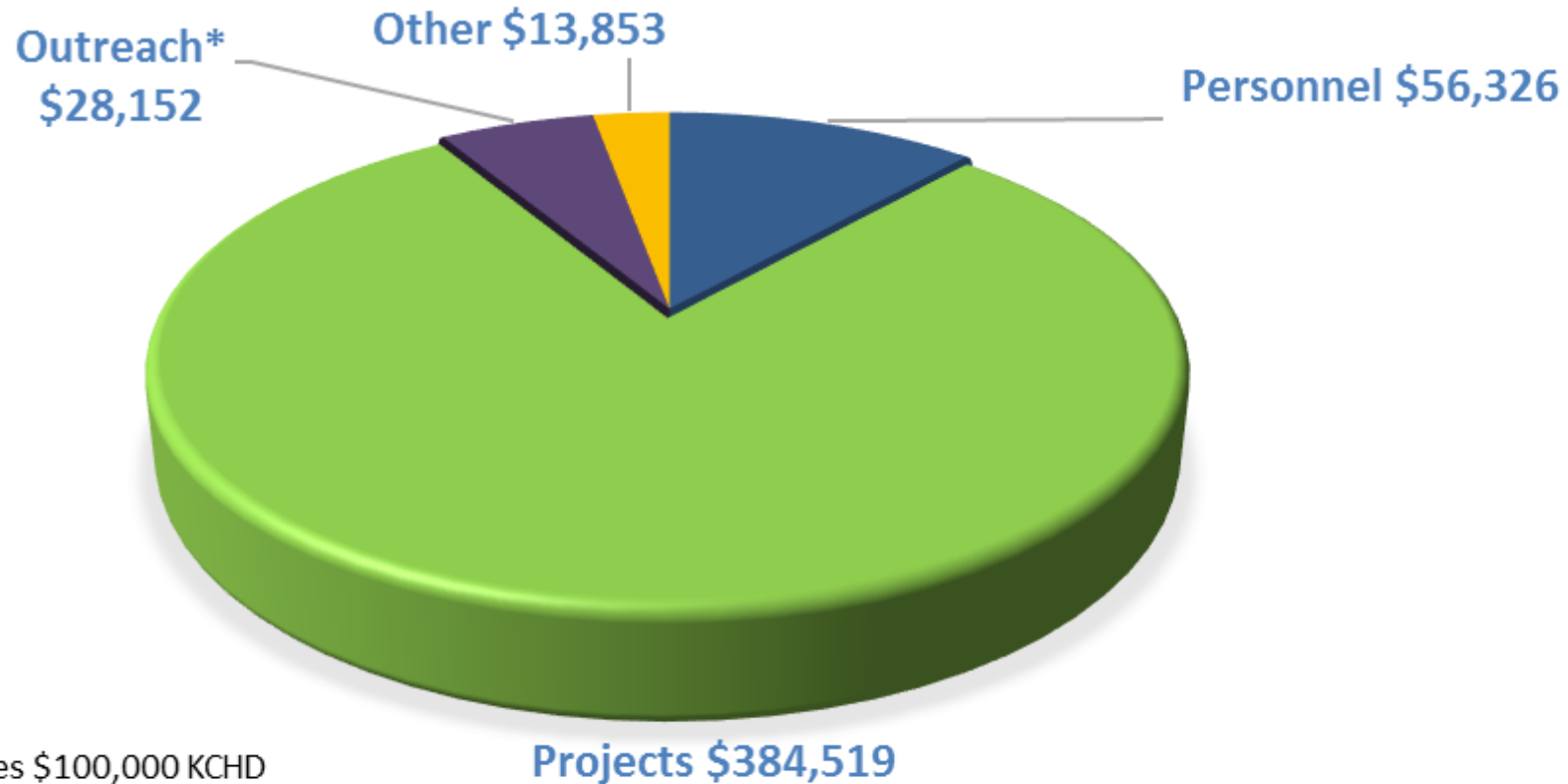

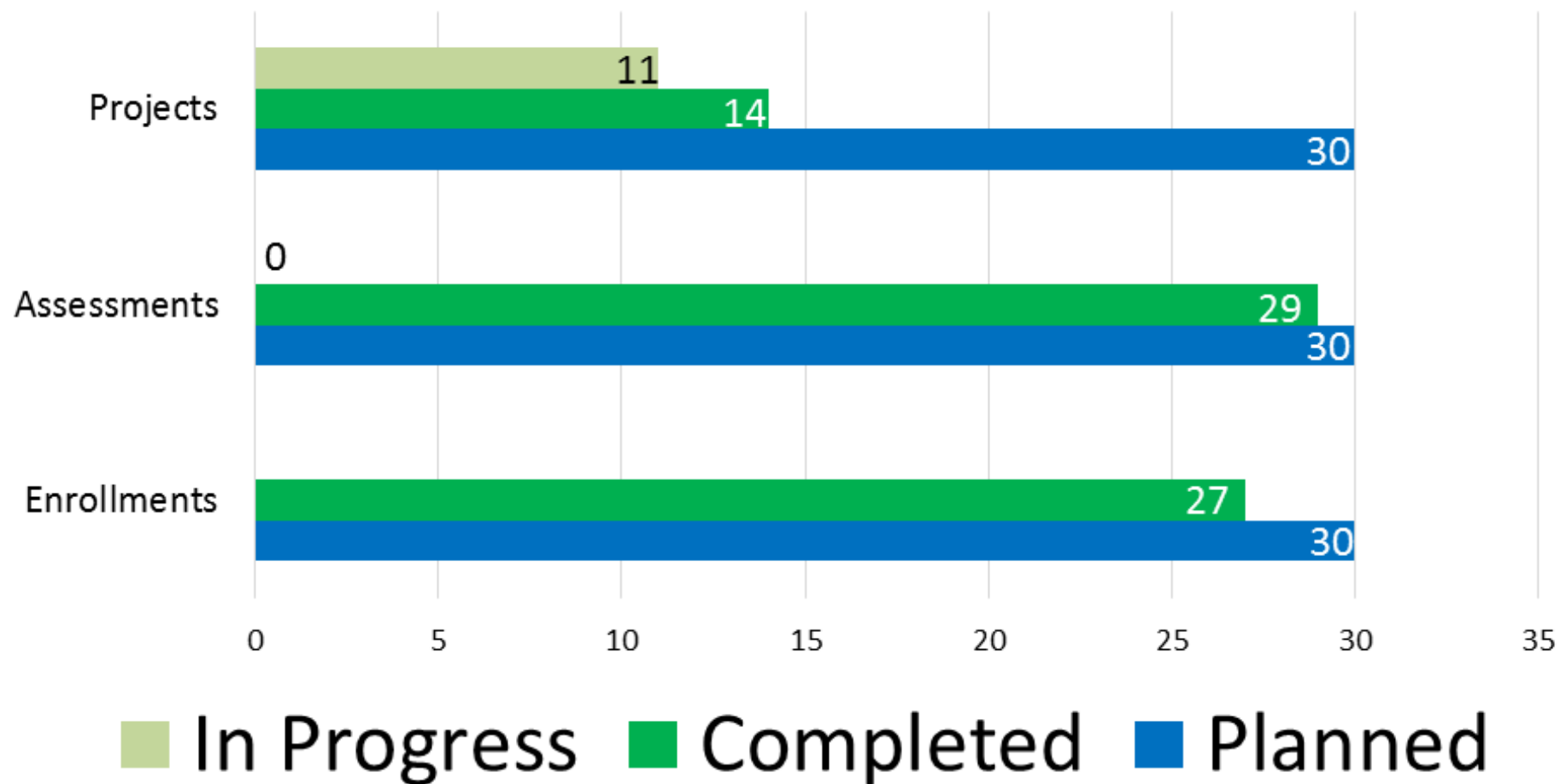
LHCCD "CHIP" 2019 GRANT EXPENDITURES - 5/31/19
