The National Community Survey[™] 2024 Results



The National Community Survey™ in Grand Rapids



The NCS™ for Grand Rapids, MI

- Third conducting The NCS (previous surveys in 2019 & 2022)
- Survey conducted from January 31st, 2024 to March 21st, 2024
- Mailing approach employed:
 - 600 total responses received
 - 16% overall response rate
 - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 839 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Grand Rapids overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 4% margin of error



Major Findings



Highest-performing areas:

- The local economy remains strong.
- Grand Rapids' affordability ratings held steady.
- Grand Rapids' cultural opportunities received overwhelmingly positive reviews.
- Most aspects pertaining to community inclusivity increased over previous survey results.

Lowest-performing areas:

• Crime prevention and law enforcement services remain an opportunity for additional focus.


