



## **Auto Theft Totals January – August**








## **Auto Thefts – Monthly**








## **Robbery Totals January – August**








## **Aggravated Assault Totals January – August**

# **Other Updates**

### **Cleared Homicides**

- National Average: 55%
- GRPD 2021 Clearance rate: 79%
- GRPD 2022 Clearance rate: 77%
- GRPD 2023 Clearance rate: 71%
- GRPD 2024 Clearance rate: 77%
- 6 of 9 homicides in 2025 cleared by arrest

### Other

- 11 recorded fatal overdoses year-to-date
- 308 illegally possessed guns recovered year-to-date





# **Addressing Domestic Violence**

- Grant collaboration and current advocate access
- Danger Assessment for Law Enforcement (DA-LE)
  - Screening done on-scene by sworn officers when they encounter a victim/survivor of Intimate Partner Violence
  - Goal is to increase identification of victims/survivors at high risk for lethal or near-lethal injury
  - Immediate connection to advocacy for those at high risk
- High-Risk Team
  - Will include representatives from victim service agencies, police, prosecution and corrections
  - Purpose is to review cases, share information, and coordinate services and supports for victims





# **Estimated Project Timeline**

#### October 2025:

- Survivor Listening Session hosted by grant partners to get feedback on project
- Training on the Danger Assessment (the original assessment from which the DA-LE was developed)
  provided to community-based advocates

#### November 2025:

 Training on the DA-LE for advocates, GRPD officers, community partners, Prosecution, court staff, and other stakeholders

### December 2025:

Full implementation of the DA-LE

### Spring 2026:

- Policy development and planning for the High-Risk Team
- Data collection from DA-LE implementation
- Full implementation of the High-Risk Team
