


Lower Reach (Bridge Street to Fulton)

Lower Grand River Habitat Restoration Project

Project Purpose:

The purpose of the project is to Restore the rapids, improve public safety, restore aquatic habitat diversity and suitability for native Great Lakes fish and mussel species and enhance river access and use.

Project Objectives:

- Remove the low-head dams and the associated public safety hazards
- Achieve fish passage and aquatic habitat enhancement targets established by MDNR
- Diversify recreational opportunities
- Develop as aesthetically and functionally natural stream design as possible
- Include safe river access
- Protect critical infrastructure
- Restore rapids
- Avoid and minimize bed instability and public safety concerns associated with increases in flow velocities and scour potential
