Overview

- Declared on February 8, 2024, in response to severe weather, tornadoes, and flooding August 24-26, 2023
- Declaration covers nine (9) counties, including Kent County and City of Grand Rapids
- Individual Assistance (IA) provides grants or low interest loans for temporary housing, home repairs, uninsured property losses and more
- Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) Teams have gone door-to-door advocating about this opportunity
- Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) was open for one-week in Alpine Township
