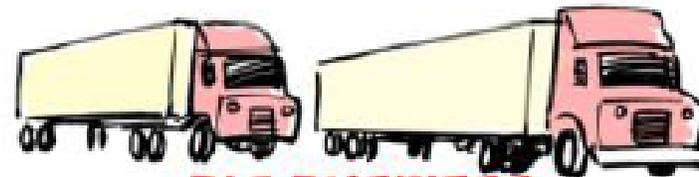

- Resurfacing project on Michigan Street (Maryland to Leffingwell)
- Install sidewalk on the north side of Michigan Street
- Plant new street trees
- 2025 Construction

City Ordinance Reminders

- The clearing of ice and snow on sidewalks is the property owner's responsibility.
- The full width of the sidewalk needs to be cleared down to the concrete within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall.
- Maintaining the parkway is the property owner's responsibility. Parkway is the area between the curb and sidewalk.
