

### Proposed Pedestrian Crossing Improvements

The City of Grand Rapids will install fourteen (14) pedestrian-activated crossing beacons at the following locations:

1. 32 <sup>nd</sup> Street SE midblock between Brook Trail SE and Sunrise St SE (Ward 3)	8. Lane Avenue NW at Sibley Street NW (Ward 1)
2. Alger Street SE at Blaine Avenue SE (Ward 3)	9. Madison Avenue SE at Hoyt Street SE (Ward 3)
3. Covell Road NW at Tremont Blvd NW (Ward 1)	10. Madison Avenue SE at Pleasant Street SE (Ward 3)
4. Diamond Avenue NE at Baldwin Street NE (Ward 2)	11. Martin Luther King Street SE at Benjamin Avenue SE (Ward 3)
5. Fuller Avenue NE at Northlawn Street NE (Ward 2)	12. Richmond Street NW at Powers Avenue NW (Ward 1)
6. Fulton Street E west of Gay Avenue NE (Ward 2)	13. Walker Avenue NW at Fremont Avenue NW (Ward 1)
7. Lafayette Avenue NE at Coldbrook Street NE (Ward 2)	14. Walker Avenue NW at Garfield Avenue NW (Ward 1)

These intersections were targeted to improve pedestrian access and safety at crossings that serve various services and/or destinations in the community, including:

- School crossings
- Transit access
- Park and trail access
- Bikeway crossings
- Business and grocery access
