OFFICE OF OVERSIGHT AND PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY

- Responsible for Independent investigation of OIS per City policy
- The purpose of using a third party is to promote fairness and remove perceived or actual conflicts of interest
- City has no authority over the investigation, including timeline
- Generally, the investigation will include witness interviews, collection of all evidence (medical examiner reports, photographs, videos, ballistics, etc.), and a thorough review of evidence
- After investigation complete, will provide its investigation to the Prosecuting Attorney and GRPD

- Receives MSP reports and evidence
- Reviews MSP's reports
- May conduct/request further investigation
- Determines whether criminal charges will be issued
- Not subject to any specific timelines or deadlines under the law

- Receives MSP's reports and evidence
- Completes an employment investigation
- May conduct additional investigation
- Determines whether City/GRPD rules, procedures, and/or polices were violated
- Will move as quickly as possible to make an employment decision

- Receives and reviews all available evidence, including MSP's reports, to the extent allowed by law
- Receives periodic updates from GRPD during their Internal Affairs Investigation
- Evaluates GRPD's IA report and findings
- Conducts full audit post IA investigation
- Releases audit findings publicly, redacted to the extent required by law, as quickly as possible
