Concept Design

Streets account for the biggest percentage of public space in our City and construction presents an opportunity to change a street's design to serve all users.

The design described below was decided upon based on the guidance and recommendations in the City's Vital Streets Plan and Bicycle Action Plan. Please visit our website and search for *Division* to see a visual of the design.

The project will:

- Place new water main.
- Reconstruct the street, curb, and gutter, including:
 - Moving the curbs in on both sides to narrow the street.
 - Raising the bike lanes to be level with the sidewalk.
 - Installing wider sidewalks on both sides of the street.

- Replacing all driveway approaches.
- Separate combined sewer into dedicated sanitary and storm sewers.
- Install a raised median in the center turn lane between Monroe Center Street and Library Street.
- Install new ornamental streetlights.
- Plant new street trees.
