



Fuller Avenue (Michigan Street to the Railroad) Sanitary Sewer Repair Update

The City of Grand Rapids closed Fuller Avenue north of Michigan Street to complete an urgent sanitary sewer repair. After further review, it was determined more work was needed to complete the repair.

On July 8, the Fuller Avenue and Michigan Street intersection will close for 3-4 weeks. You are receiving this letter because this work is happening near you.

The Michigan Street detour will use Diamond Avenue, Leonard Street, and Plymouth Avenue.

The northbound Fuller Avenue detour will use Michigan Street, Plymouth Avenue, and Leonard Street.

The southbound Fuller Avenue detour will use Leonard Street, Diamond Avenue, and Fulton Street.

Access to I-196 from Fuller Avenue will be maintained from the north.

Pedestrian access will be maintained. Access to businesses will be maintained.

This full closure will allow contractors to complete the work as quickly as possible.
