SUBJECT: LONG SANITARY SEWER LATERAL PIPE CONNECTIONS AND LONG WATER SERVICE PIPE CONNECTIONS

PURPOSE: To provide property owners connecting to the Grand Rapids Sewer and/or Water Systems who incur inequities of cost due to the length of such connections a measure of relief from such inequities.

POLICY:

In the event a property owner connecting to the Grand Rapids Sanitary Sewer and/or Water Systems incurs cost inequities in providing his/her property with sanitary sewer lateral pipe and/or water service pipe, an allowance may be made under the following procedure:

1. The City Engineer, in consultation with the City Assessor, will at the property owner's request, review the connection cost, determine whether an allowance shall be granted, and determine the amount of the allowance.
2. The allowance, if granted, shall consist of a credit to be applied against the front foot charge due to sanitary sewer and/or water main. The allowance shall not exceed 50% of the front foot charge due.
3. The property owner shall be ineligible for an allowance if no front foot charge is due.
4. The determination of the City Engineer, in consultation with the City Assessor, shall be final.
